

COMPOSTING NOTIFICATION

According to waste act 41 a §, the waste holder shall give the information of a small scale treatment of biowaste to municipal waste management authority. A notification shall also be given when the waste treatment is ended. The municipal waste management authority shall maintain a register in which the waste treatment information is entered (waste act 143 §). Personal data entered in the register shall be stored for five years after the waste treatment has been ended. **Composting garden waste doesn't have to be announced.**
