

CHRISTMAS-TIME WASTE RECYCLING

BIOWASTE

- Small amounts of ham fat can be sorted in biowaste collection or in the composter, e.g. as absorbed in paper towels or egg carton
- Christmas flowers, Christmas wreaths and Christmas decorations made from natural materials

MIXED WASTE

- ham oven bags
- the fat that comes off when roasting the ham, into a milk can carefully packed
- wrapping paper and packing tape, cellophane
- plastic and glass ornaments
- funeral candle glass (metal lid for metal waste)
- funeral candle plastic (metal lid for metal waste)
- the glasses of the grave lantern
- candle ends, lanterns and oil candles
- plastic covers for tealight candles
- dirty wrapping paper and cardboard
- craft cardboard, paper shreds

PLASTIC PACKAGES

- plastic packaging materials
- cellophane packages
- packing styrofoams, bubble wraps
- plastic inner parts of juice and wine containers, including taps
- the insides of Christmas calendars and chocolate boxes

CARDBOARD AND CARTON

- cardboard and cardboard packaging, chocolate boxes and Christmas calendars
- milk, juice and mulled wine cans (including those lined with aluminum)
- cardboard covers of juice and wine packages

PAPER

- newspapers used as frost insulation in flower packages

METAL

- metal cans, aluminum tins and foils, lids and caps
- metal casings for tealight candles and outdoor fires
- metal caps for funeral candles
- metal lanterns and lantern holders
- aluminum foils

GLASS PACKAGES

- glass bottles (beverage packages to bottle return systems)
- glass jars

ELECTRICAL DEVICES

- devices and children's toys that work with mains power, with a battery or are rechargeable
- light sets and candles that work with mains power, battery or are rechargeable
- headlamps and spotlights
- led grave candles

CHRISTMAS TREE

- you can bring a Christmas tree free of charge to The Hevossuo Waste Treatment Centre
- you can put a chopped Christmas tree in your own mixed waste container
- you can put a whole Christmas tree next to the waste container, to wait for the garbage truck. It will be charged the price of emptying the container
- you can burn a chopped Christmas tree in the fire pit of your own property

NEW YEARS TIN

- to the hazardous waste reception site, to The Hevossuo Waste Treatment Centre

FIREWORKS

- the plastic wrappers of the fireworks are sorted into plastic packages
- cardboard and paper packaging of fireworks into cardboard packaging
- used firework rockets cardboard sleeves, sticks and plastic plugs and the like for mixed waste
- used sparklers are sorted into metal waste
- unused and expired firework rockets are delivered to points of sale or to the authorities (police)

BATTERIES

- batteries and small batteries are returned with the ends taped to the collection point, which can be found at every battery seller from the point of sale
